RV Issues

Front Bunk lowers/raises at angle or not at all.

When bunk is lowered, it crushes dash.

Night Shade just spins and does not lower.

Washer/Dryer unit makes clicking and cycling noises and it has never been used. (I can share video as needed).

W/D cabinet doors fell off, second time different door.

Assess the w/d hook up and inspect the wall behind the w/d unit for integrity. It appears it was connected by stables and the wall itself looks like the wood is splintered and unstable.

Fans in cockpit are pointing toward the windshield.

Fog lamps filled with water, one inoperable.

Leak at back ramp door, top center.

Water reserve elbow joint is broken.

Laminate bubbled/bubbles under front passenger seat perhaps damage from windshield leakage.

Paneling through RV is not fixed in place, e.g. above washer/dryer cabinet is not attached; Cabinet across from bathroom right side panel is warped or not attached properly.

Velcro on shades don't attach to anything.

Shower not sealed properly and leaks on floor with shower door closed.

Sliding back glass door track not screwed in completely to make secure.

Foldout couch bed screws came out, was repaired once at Leo's RV, should be checked for safety.

Front vents on dash filled with water when windshield leaked, should be cleaned out properly to prevent mold.

Shelving does not appear to be proper width/length and falls in motion.

Shelving trim has fallen off in areas.

Wall paper in bathroom bubbled.

Freezer or Fridge door seems improperly aligned and rubs when closing/opening.

The lock and door knob for the interior door to the garage shifts exposing the door knob hole.

Rear Awning arm by main cabin door gets stuck and does not start to extend properly.

Interior passenger side slide out weather stripping is unsecure.

Motors for slide outs seems underpowered, noisy and sluggish as if straining.

While we have replaced them, the screws holding the bunk net frequently pop come out.

The tinfoil in the floor vent rattles.

The sound bar seems to connect to the camera mics or something.

Mirror cameras can not be turned off, nor are they usable at night due to placement.
